How to Make Your Payment

1. Call or go into your Farm Service Agency (FSA) county office.
2. Have a blank check (unsigned) or debit card ready.
3. Many FSA employees can help you make your payment.
4. The payments are made through [Pay.gov](https://www.pay.gov), the U.S Treasury's online payment hub that accepts electronic payment options directly from your bank account.
