SUBJECT: Monthly Farmer Program Loan Status Report

TO: FmHA State Directors

Please have your county offices provide you with the information listed below relating to Farmer Programs, each month beginning with data for the month of August 1981. (The report for August 1981 should include activity during the last two days of July 1981.) Thereafter, the data are to be for activity occurring each calendar month from the first day of business for the month through the last day of business for the month except for those items which are counts as of the last business day. Your consolidated State monthly report should be sent via electronic mail to the Management Information Systems Division (NO-MISD) no later than seven work days after close of business of the report month. (The August report is not due in MISD until September 15, 1981.)

Your report should show the subject as "Farmer Program Loan Status Report for (month year)" and simply list the data by item number as in the list below. (These are the same items which you reported weekly during April-July 1981.)

1. Number of EM applications "received" during the month.
2. Number of EM applications on hand "unprocessed" (no action taken other than to receive) on the last business day of the month.
3. Number of EM applications that are "in process" but not approved, withdrawn or rejected on the last business day of the month.
4. Number of EM applications "approved" during the month. (This is to be the count of individual applications approved, not the count of FmHA 1940-1's.)
5. Number of approved EM applicants whose checks have been ordered but not received on last business day of the month. (Obligation requests have been sent to the Finance Office.)
6. Total amount of EM loan funds "obligated" (Form 440-57's received by the county office from the Finance Office) during the month.
7. Number of EM borrowers for which checks are "on hand" but loan(s) are unclosed on last business day of the month.
8. Number of EM borrowers whose loans were "closed" during the month.
9. Number of EM applications "withdrawn or rejected" during the month.

10. Number of temporary emergency employees on the payroll by job title, i.e., loan officers, clerks, and contractor employees processing and servicing loans on last business day of the month.
11. Number of borrowers who "requested" their Farmer Program loans to be rescheduled or reamortized during the month.
12. Number of borrowers whose Farmer Program loans were rescheduled or reamortized during the month.
13. Number of borrowers who "requested" deferral of principal and/or interest payments on their Farmer Program loans during the month.
14. Number of borrowers who "received" deferrals of principal and/or interest payments on their Farmer Program loans during the month.
15. Number of Farmer Program borrowers who are in process of foreclosure (where letter of acceleration has been issued, or with chattel, where the liquidation process has been started) as of the last business day of the month. (This is to be the total number of borrowers in this category, not "just" those occurring during the month.)
 - a. By other lenders that are in prior or junior lien position to FmHA.
 - b. By FmHA.
16. Number of borrowers who completed voluntary liquidation during the month.
17. Number of borrowers who have filed a petition in bankruptcy as of the last business day of the month. (The total number in this category, not "just" those occurring during the month.)

Your cooperation in providing this information accurately and on time is necessary.
