FmHA AN No. 1003 (1940)

SUBJECT: Apportionment of Economic Emergency (EE) Loan Funds

TO: All State Directors, Assistant Administrator, Accounting,
and Director, Finance Office

This AN supercedes AN No. 986 (1940) dated March 9, 1984, and the unnumbered memo dated March 30, 1984, on the subject.

The Office of Management and Budget (OMB) has approved an additional amount of insured EE loan funds. Attachment A sets forth the amounts of insured and guaranteed EE loan funds each State may obligate. Column 1 on pages 1 and 2 of Attachment A shows the insured EE loan allocation amounts. The total amount of insured EE loans that have ALREADY BEEN OBLIGATED FOR EACH STATE MUST BE SUBTRACTED from the insured EE allocation to arrive at the remaining insured balance.

Column 2 on pages 1 and 2 of Attachment A shows the guaranteed EE loan allocation amounts. Column 3 shows the amount of guaranteed EE loan funds each State has obligated as of March 30, 1984. This includes amounts some States have already received from the National Office reserve. Column 4 shows the amount of guaranteed EE loan funds each State has remaining. We will constantly monitor guaranteed EE loan making and make any changes necessary in the allocation.

Insured EE loan applications which were previously approved but not funded because they exceeded a State's allocation may be transmitted to the Finance Office for funding 24 hours after receipt of this notice, so long as these applications do not exceed each State's allocation established in this AN. Such applications should be funded in order, based upon the date of approval. If insured funds remain after these requests are funded, unapproved insured loan applications should be considered for approval, based upon the date of application, including those applications that had been handled in accordance with AN No. 986 (1940). Please remember that applicants who own and operate not larger than family farms will have their loan applications given preference as set forth in FmHA Instruction 1945.112(b)(1). A new application received from an applicant whose earlier application for an insured EE loan was withdrawn because of the lack of insured EE funds, to the extent possible, will be treated as being filed on the date the original application was filed.



When allocated insured EE loan funds have been exhausted, County Supervisors must continue to accept insured EE applications and process such applications UP TO THE POINT OF APPROVAL (this means right up to the point Form FmHA 1940-1 would be signed by the loan approval official). The continued processing of insured loans after the allocated amount has been reached is required by the Court's Order dated March 30, 1984, on the case of KJELDAHL v. BLOCK. We will notify you of any later changes in this requirement.

State Directors are reminded to monitor EE loan processing and to make requests for reserve funds from the National Office as previously stated in An No. 986 (1940).
