SUBJECT: Category 2 Borrowers, Second Appeal

TO: All FmHA State Directors, Farmer Program Chiefs, District
Directors, County Supervisors, and State Directors-at-Large

PURPOSE/INTENDED OUTCOME

The purpose of this Administrative Notice (AN) is to set forth the policy in determining whether Category 2 borrowers are entitled to a second appeal.

COMPARISON WITH PREVIOUS AN

No previous AN has been issued on this subject.

IMPLEMENTATION RESPONSIBILITIES

AN 1335, dated February 3, 1986, informed the field offices to send all Category 2 borrowers who were in monetary default as of December 31, 1985, a letter and Form FmHA 1924-14. If a borrower requested any of the servicing actions and was rejected, the borrower was given appeal rights. Subsequently, Category 2 borrowers were sent Forms FmHA 1924-14, 1924-25, and 1924-26 per AN 1369, dated March 14, 1986. Forms FmHA 1924-25 and 1924-26 advise borrowers that they have the right to apply for servicing actions and appeal the denial of such actions (seventh paragraph on 1924-25 and Part II of 1924-26). It has been determined that those borrowers who previously appealed a denial of servicing actions as a result of receiving the County Supervisor's letter and Form FmHA 1924-14 will be given a second appeal if they request one on Form FmHA 1924-26.
