EXCHANGE OF CCC-OWNED SUGAR
FOR USE IN DOMESTIC PROGRAMS

The Commodity Credit Corporation (CCC) invites offers, subject to the terms and conditions of Announcement KCEC1, to exchange CCC-owned sugar stocks for delivery of refined white granulated sugar, packed in 50 lb. bags with standard commercial markings, on pallets and stretchwrapped.

The refined white granulated sugar is to be packaged in 50 lb. bags (kraft or poly lined) and shall be palletized on 40" x 48" pallets with a slip sheet over pallet and NO OVERHANG ON PALLETS. Each pallet will contain approximately 50 bags; loaded weight shall be approximately 2,500 pounds, with a minimum of 3 layers of qualified stretchwrap per pallet to be used. Each truck totaling a minimum of 38,000 pounds to a maximum of 42,000 pounds of refined white granulated sugar to be delivered per location with the following EXCEPTIONS:

Offerors must submit an offer for the entire quantity listed in the respective offer number. Successful contractors will receive CCC-owned sugar in exchange for the quantity awarded of refined white granulated bagged sugar.

In formulating the offer, the offeror should note that delivery of the sugar by CCC shall be instore at the location specified in the contract. Any difference between the quality and quantity surrendered by CCC and that actually delivered to the contractor by the storing warehouse shall be settled between the contractor and the storing warehouse.

Offerors are advised to check with the storing warehouse regarding scheduling, quality, and location of refined or raw sugar. Offerors are strongly urged to establish, prior to making an offer, the premium and discount schedules in case of quality or location discrepancies. Contractors must pay applicable charges to the storing warehouse. Commodity delivered by contractor must be produced in the United States, as specified in the announcement.

Storage for the account of CCC shall be through the date of transfer of title as evidenced on the wire release which will occur when all proper documentation is received in KCCO, BUT NO LATER THAN OCTOBER 25, 2001. The contractor shall be responsible for all charges thereafter.

Offerors will list the quantity of sugar from the attached exhibit, designating the lot, location and quantity in exchange for the quantity of refined white granulated bagged sugar specified in the offer. Only one partial lot is permitted. In

formulating the offer, the offeror should note that CCC-owned sugar will be received by the contractor instore, at storage locations specified in this Invitation under the attached exhibit.

CCC has the option to award less than quantity offered. Each offer will be analyzed independently. No offer will be contingent upon any other offer.

Any actual damages suffered by CCC resulting from any failure or refusal of contractor to perform, shall be for the account of the contractor. Such actual damages shall include, but not be limited to: storage and excess replacement costs.

8. COMMODITY SPECIFICATIONS

Add B. Quality Specifications for U.S. Refined White Granulated Sugar (Bagged)

Type I: White (Refined)

Class A: Granulated (fine or extrafine)

Salient Characteristics:

Processing: The sugar shall be obtained from sugar cane or sugar beets and prepared in accordance with good commercial and manufacturing practices.

Odor, flavor, and color: The finished sugar shall have an odor, flavor, and color of the type and style specified.

Consistency: The finished sugar shall not contain lumps larger than 0.5 inch in their greatest dimension that cannot be broken by light finger pressure.

Foreign material: The sugar shall be visibly absent of foreign material (e.g.; metal, wood, glass, insects, insect fragments, or filth), and meet the

vendor's standard specifications.

Physical properties: The sugar shall conform to the following sieve size requirements when examined on a Ro-Tap or equivalent shaking device fitted with the specified sized sieves using recognized commercial procedures.

U.S. Standard No. 20 Sieve: Maximum to remain on sieve (percent by weight) is 5

U.S. Standard No. 100 Sieve: Maximum to pass through sieve (percent by weight) is 10

Analytical requirements: Minimum sucrose 99.5 percent
Maximum ash 0.04 percent
Maximum moisture 0.05 percent

Analytical testing: Analyses shall be made in accordance with the Official Methods of Analysis of the AOAC International as follows:

<u>Test</u>	<u>Method</u>
Sucrose	925.46
Ash	900.02A
Moisture	925.45A at 65 degrees Centigrade

General: Must comply with all regulations under the Federal Food, Drug and Cosmetic Act, and be manufactured in accordance with Current Good Manufacturing Practices. The product shall not have a foreign taste or emit any objectionable odor in dry form or when a 10% solution is acidified to a pH of 2.5 with USP phosphoric acid and allowed to stand for 72 hours.

Add C. (1) Quality Assurance

The contractor must perform the product testing and quality analysis to ensure that the product analysis meets the specifications described in paragraph 8.B. The results must be evidenced by a Certificate of Analysis. The contractor must retain a copy of the Certificate of Analysis and provide a copy with each shipment.

Add D. Liquidated Damages

Compensation to USDA for Delay in Delivery

Liquidated damages for delay in delivery will be payable in accordance with Article 67 of USDA-1, and will be at the rate of \$0.10 per 100 pounds (net weight) per day.
