

**COMMODITY CREDIT CORPORATION
FY 2001 APPROPRIATIONS ACT, DETAIL OF SENATE ACTION**

The following provisions relating to CCC were added to H.R. 4461, Division B, by amendments on the Senate floor. The House-passed bill contains no comparable provisions, with the exception of market and quality losses for apples and potatoes, and the definition of the 1999 nursery crop.

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OTHER PROVISIONS:

- § 1103 defines livestock for the purposes of the Livestock Indemnity Program.
- § 1108 defines nursery crop losses from Hurricane Irene on October 16 and 17, 1999, as 1999-crop losses.
- § 1112, which provides \$2.5 million for the South Carolina Grain Dealers Guaranty Fund, may be funded by CCC.
- § 1113 provides that such sums as the Secretary considers necessary may be transferred to the Wildlife Habitat Incentive Program from the \$50 million conservation assistance funding made available by Sec. 211 of the Agricultural Risk Protection Act.
- Division B, Title II, General Provisions §2105, prohibits recovering erroneous payments to oyster fishermen in Connecticut.
