WEEKLY WOOL NATIONAL MARKET PRICE

Washington September 8, 2015 - The U. S. Department of Agriculture's Commodity Credit Corporation today announced posted prices for wool. The effective repayment rate is the lower of either the 30-day average or weekly rate.
