

## 2008 Wool & Mohair Loan Deficiency Program (LDP) Receipts Deadline January 31, 2009



**Did you file a CCC-633EZ Page 1 with our office? Have you sold your wool/mohair?**

If so, you must **submit your sales receipt's** and a completed CCC-633EZ Page 4 to this office on or before the Jan. 31, 2009 deadline.

If you have **already submitted your sales receipts and** filed a CCC-633EZ Page 4 , then **NO ACTION** is required.

The Wool/Mohair LDP program is designed to support the wool and mohair industry by supplementing the price producers receive for their product when market prices fall below a minimum (“Loan”) level.

To be eligible for the 2008 Wool/Mohair LDP program, a producer must first sign an “LDP Agreement & Request” form **CCC-633EZ, Page 1** before relinquishing beneficial interest in their product.

In order to receive a payment, the producer must then complete a **CCC-633EZ, Page 4** along with their sales receipts detailing their product, quantity, date of sale or loss of beneficial interest and price received.

Payment rates depend on the date the producer sells or relinquishes beneficial interest in their wool/mohair. LDP rates can be viewed at <http://www.fsa.usda.gov/> and by clicking on the applicable region. [Region 2: Navajo, Apache County - Region 3: Coconino County]

### Types of receipts

The image shows three sample receipts. The first is from COWTOWN FEED & LIVESTOCK, dated 5-23-08, for white and colored wool. The second is from the COCONINO COUNTY USDA Farm Service Agency Office, dated 06-18-08, for white and colored wool. The third is from the Inscription House Trading Post, dated May 27 2008, for white mohair. Each receipt has a 'sample' watermark and a 'RECEIVED' stamp.
