Jan. 15- Blueberries, Strawberries, Oranges

March 15- Plums, Peaches, Olives, Alfalfa, Apples, Spring Oats

June 15- Forage Seeding

July 15- Grazing Grass

\*multi planting crops must be reported within 15 days of harvest ex: Peas
