To whom it may concern:

This letter is in response to a request from the Government of Rwanda for information about corn exports provided through United States Government food assistance programs to Rwanda or transiting Rwanda. Specifically, the Government of Rwanda inquired as to the presence of transgenic/biotech corn varieties in food aid shipments of processed corn products.

The transgenic corn varieties commercially produced in the United States have been reviewed under the U.S. regulatory process for evaluating the safety of new agricultural biotechnology products. This evaluation process is well coordinated among the U.S. regulatory agencies and sets the U.S. regulatory standards for human, animal, and plant health, and environmental safety. Extensive information about transgenic corn varieties produced in the United States is available through the United States Regulatory Agencies' Unified Biotechnology Website (<http://usbiotechreg.nbii.gov/>) and the Biosafety Clearing-House website (<http://bch.biodiv.org/>).

Corn varieties, including commercialized transgenic varieties, used for export, including food aid, are the same as those used for domestic consumption. In the United States, transgenic crops are not commonly differentiated or segregated either for domestic consumption or for export.

After processing, corn products would be unlikely to contain viable plant material capable of propagation in the environment.
