#### A Reasons for Amendment

- modify the additional schedule of discounts, as applicable
- add crop year 2020 schedule of premiums and discounts.

#### **B** Major Changes

Subparagraph 826 B has been added to provide 2020 premiums and discounts per bushel for other grains and wild oats.

Subparagraph 1426 C and D have been amended to provide additional premiums and discounts for Hard Red Winter and Hard White Wheat.

Subparagraph 1427 H has been amended to provide additional factors 6 through 9 to the Insect-Damaged Kernel discount table for all classes, subclasses and grades of wheat, effective July 1, 2019.

Subparagraph 1427 M has been amended to provide additional sprout damage discounts for 2020 crop for all wheat classes and subclasses.

- on and after the specified effective date.
