Cotton

Background:

On January 18, 2006, in Notice to the Trade BCD-117, USDA allowed warehouse operators located in certain eligible counties to request approval for short-term outside storage of cotton under loan. Notice to the Trade BCD-130 extended the deadline for moving loan collateral into approved space until May 1, 2006. This Notice informs those parties with cotton loan collateral remaining in temporary space as of May 1, of actions anticipated by the Commodity Credit Corporation (CCC).

Action:

Any warehouse operator with CCC loan collateral located in unapproved space will be immediately removed from the List of Approved Warehouses. CCC will notify producers whose loan cotton is not stored in approved space as of May 1, 2006 that the maturity date of their loan on such cotton is advanced to 30 days from the date of the notification letter. On or after 15 days from the date of the notification letter, the loan cannot be redeemed with a CCC Commodity Certificate or forfeited, and any redemption of the loan after that date must be at the principal amount of the loan plus interest. If the loan is not redeemed, a claim will be established for the amount due, and CCC will take action to market the loan collateral and apply any proceeds form the sale to the amount of the claim.
