1	New Year's Day Holiday. FSA offices are closed.
17	County Committee election ballots must be returned to your local County FSA Office or postmarked by the 17 th (2014 Only).
15	Final date to report apples, grapes & peaches.
20	Birthday of Martin Luther King, Jr. FSA offices are closed.
31	Final availability date for 2012 Marketing Assistance Loans & LDPs for wool & unshorn pelts.
February	
17	George Washington's Birthday. FSA offices are closed.
18	Elected County Committee members & alternates take office (2014 Only).
28	NAP application closing date for rice.
March	
15	NAP application closing date for many NAP crops, including forage and pasture. (Since the 15 th falls on a weekend, applications will be accepted through 3/17)
31	Final availability date for 2013 Marketing Assistance Loans & LDPs for small grains & honey.
April	
15	Sign-up begins for Livestock Forage Disaster Program (LFP), Livestock Indemnity Program (LIP), Emergency Assistance for Livestock, Honeybees, & Farm-raised Fish Program (ELAP), & Tree Assistance Program.
May	
1	NAP application closing date for ornamental nursery.
15	Final date to report spring oats & potatoes.
26	Memorial Day Holiday. FSA offices are closed.
31	Final availability date for 2013 Marketing Assistance Loans & LDPs for feed grains, upland cotton, soybeans & minor oilseeds. (Since the 31 st falls on a weekend, applications will be accepted through 6/2).
June	
15	County Committee nomination period begins. Nomination forms are available from your local FSA Office.
July	
4	Independence Day. FSA offices are closed.
15	Final date to report CRP, burley tobacco, corn, cotton, grain sorghum, hybrid corn seed, popcorn, rice, soybeans & all other crops. NAP crops must be reported by the final reporting date or 15 days before harvest.
15	2013 ACRE production reports for planted acres for covered commodities on the farm due.
August	
1	Final date to request a reconstitution-combining or dividing farms or tracts of land based on the farming operation.
1	Last day to file County Committee nomination forms at the local FSA Office.

September	
1	Labor Day Holiday. FSA offices are closed.
1	NAP application closing date for greens, aquaculture, Christmas trees, ginseng root, turf grass sod, mushrooms & floriculture. <i>(Since the 1st falls on a Federal Holiday, applications will be accepted through 9/2).</i>
30	NAP application closing date for strawberries & fall-seeded small grains.
October	
13	Columbus Day Holiday. FSA offices are closed.
November	
3	COC election ballots mailed to eligible voters.
11	Veterans Day Holiday. FSA offices are closed.
15	Final date to report apiculture & pasture, rangeland & forage. <i>(Since the 15th falls on a weekend, reports will be accepted through 11/17)</i>
20	NAP application closing date for apples, apricots, grapes, nectarines, peaches, pears, plums, prunes & blueberries.
27	Thanksgiving Day Holiday. FSA offices are closed.
December	
1	NAP application closing date for honey.
1	Last day to return voted County Committee ballots to the local FSA Office.
15	Final date to report fall barley, fall wheat & all other fall-seeded small grains.
25	Christmas Day Holiday. FSA offices are closed.
31	NAP application closing date for potatoes.

1	Newly elected county committee members take office.
1	New Year's Day Holiday. FSA offices are closed.

Reports of Failed Acreage must be filed with the County Office before disposition of the crop.	
Reports of Prevented Planting Acreage must be filed with the County Office no later than 15 calendar days after the final planting date for that county.
