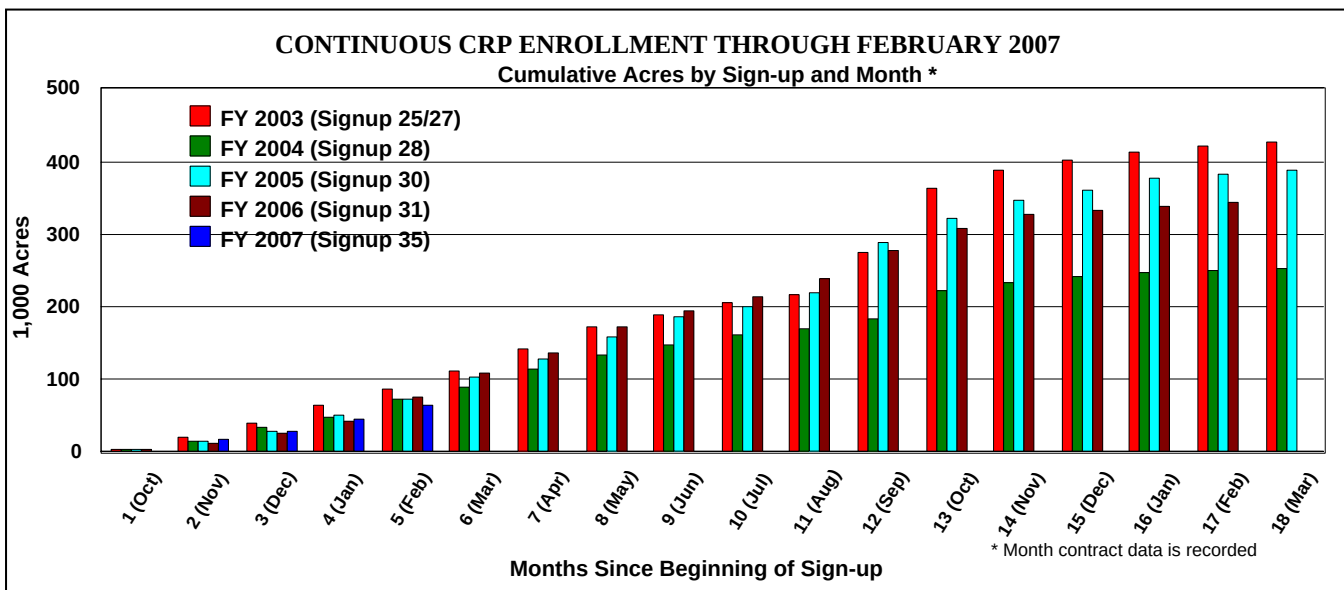

CRP ENROLLMENT ACTIVITY AND NEWS

- Preliminary results of last year's re-enrollment and extension (REX) offer for the 15.8 million general sign-up acres under contracts originally set to expire 9/30/2007 show contracts on 13.1 million acres are now in the active contract files as having approved new or extended contracts (see p. 16).
- Preliminary results of the REX offer to holders of 12.5 million general sign-up acres under 2008-, 2009-, and 2010-expiring contracts indicate that requests for a compliance check, a prerequisite for accepting the re-enrollment or extension offer, have been made on 10.1 million acres. Data on acres approved for new or extended contracts are not yet available.
- The contract expiration schedule is now completely changed due to REX, and a new schedule is provided (p. 17) based on preliminary results. Actual acres re-enrolling, extending, and expiring each year is uncertain at this time, as data on acceptances are still being recorded.
- Since Earth Day, April 22, 2004, contracts on 185,530 acres of wetland practices (including adjacent upland buffers) have been approved. As of February 2007, wetland practice contracts (including general and continuous sign-up) total 2.05 million acres.

- FY 2007's continuous sign-up 35 is proceeding at about 11% below FY 2006's sign-up 31. Sign-up 31 now projects to end up at 350,000 acres.
- Preliminary results for the Emergency Forestry CRP show that 180,176 acres have been approved for enrollment in 5 States (see p. 3).

General Signup. Producers with eligible lands compete nationally for acceptance based on an environmental benefits index (EBI) during specified enrollment periods. Producers may submit offers below soil-specific maximum rental rates and select wildlife-enhancing vegetative covers to increase EBI ranking.

Continuous (Non-CREP) Sign-up. Producers with eligible lands may enroll certain high priority conservation practices, such as filter strips and riparian buffers, at any time during the year without competition. In addition to annual soil rental payment and cost-share assistance, many practices are eligible for additional annual and one-time up-front financial incentives. Land enrolled under various initiatives are included in this category.

Conservation Reserve Enhancement Program (CREP). Under CREP agreements, Federal/State partnerships, implement projects designed to address specific environmental objectives through targeted CRP enrollments. Sign-up is held on a continuous basis, general sign-up practices may be included, and additional financial incentives are generally provided. There are 38 agreements are currently in effect in 29 States.

Farmable Wetland Program (FWP). Producers enroll small non-flood plain wetlands under modified continuous sign-up provisions.

The accompanying tables are based on contract data developed and maintained in CRP data files by USDA Service Centers through February 2007, and are based on the physical location of the CRP contracted land. Some adjustments have been made to correct mis-coded data in the active contract files. Farmable Wetland Program contracts are not included in the continuous sign-up tables.

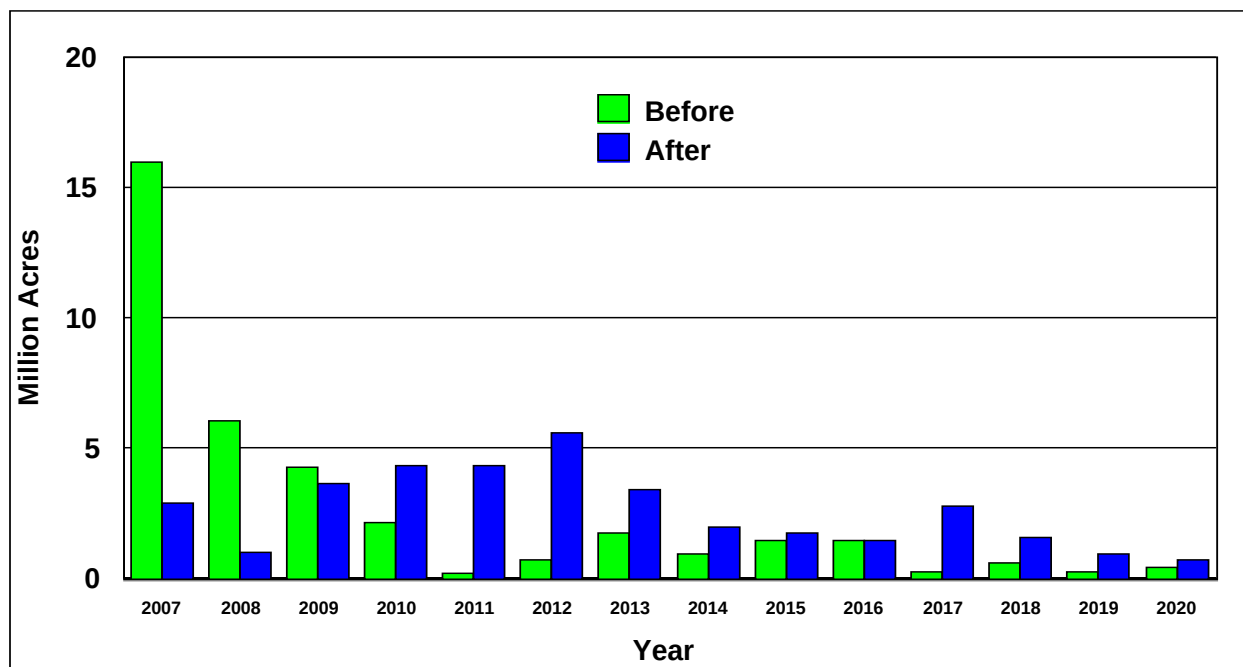
