

Electronic Wisconsin FSA Newsletter Sign-up



Previously, Farm Service Agency (FSA) has used bulk mail to send newsletters and reminders to keep producers up-to-date on program changes and sign-up deadlines. However, due to budget constraints, FSA has

moved to electronic mail.

Signing up for FSA E-mail

There are two options producers have to sign up to receive e-mail from FSA.

Option 1

Individuals can subscribe to the electronic delivery service by visiting the Wisconsin FSA website at www. fsa.usda.gov/wi. Click on "Subscribe to Wisconsin FSA E-mail News" on the right side of the Wisconsin FSA homepage in the "I Want To...." box. Individuals will be prompted to enter an email address, then after clicking the "Submit" button; choose which e-mail notifications to receive, including the Wisconsin Newsletter.



Option 2

Individuals may talk to staff in their county office about filling out form AD-2047. By providing your name, email address, signature and date of record change, you are giving FSA permission to send important information via email.

Also, individuals may elect to cease receiving hard

copies of bulk mail by checking the applicable box or the "NO" option in section four of the AD-2047 form. (Tax statements, County Committee election ballots and program information that is specific to an individual's operation will continue to be sent via standard mail delivery, even if an individual opts not to receive hard copies of bulk mail.)

Once completing and signing an AD-2047, individuals will be enrolled in the free USDA GovDelivery system and will receive an email that confirms the subscription.

Maintaining Personal Account Preferences in GovDelivery



Once signed up for GovDelivery, the individual is responsible for maintaining account preferences, which include email address changes, password changes and elections of the types of email news received (i.e. local, state or national press releases).

Individuals can maintain account preferences by visiting the Wisconsin FSA website at www.fsa.usda.gov/wi. Click on "Subscribe to Wisconsin FSA E-mail News" on the right side of the Wisconsin FSA homepage in the "I Want To...." box. Individuals will be prompted to enter their current email address and click on the "Submit" button. Individuals will then be able to update or change preferences regarding which e-mail notifications are received, including the Wisconsin Newsletter.

Step-by-Step Directions to Sign-up/Update Preferences for GovDelivery

After accessing the Wisconsin FSA website at www.fsa. usda.gov/wi. Click on "Subscribe to Wisconsin FSA E-mail News" on the right side of the Wisconsin FSA homepage in the "I Want To...." box. Individuals will be prompted to enter an email address if this is the first time signing up. If users are updating information, please enter the email address that FSA e-mail is currently being received.



Individuals will be prompted to confirm their email address. A password does not have to be created to access the account. Individuals may leave the password boxes blank. Click "Submit".
