**1/31/10** - 2009 final loan and LDP availability date for Wool, Mohair, Unshorn Pelts

**3/31/10** - 2009 final loan or LDP availability date for Barley, Canola, Crambe, Flaxseed, Honey, Oats, Rapeseed, Wheat, Sesame Seed

**5/31/10** - 2009 final loan or LDP availability date for Corn, Dry Peas, Grain Sorghum, Lentils, Mustard Seed, Safflower Seed, Small Chickpeas, Soybeans, Sunflower Seed

- NAP coverage is NOT available on any crop that is insurable in the County at any level of maturity. (No more young orchards)
- Nursery Crops are Insurable in ALL California Counties. (crop coverage can be verified by a Crop Ins. Agent for your county)
- for annual crops coverage begins the later of either of the following:
  - 30 calendar days after the date CCC-471 is filed
  - Or the date the crop is planted, not to exceed the final planting date
