ANNOUNCEMENT KCPBS2 Invitation No. 1 Purchase of Raw Cane or Refined Beet Sugar

On June 17, 2013, the Commodity Credit Corporation (CCC) announced in a Federal Register Notice its intention to purchase sugar in exchange for Refined Sugar Re-export Program (RSRP) credits.

CCC initially intended to purchase an aggregate quantity of 90,000 metric tons (MT) of raw cane sugar or refined beet sugar under this Invitation. However, due to government-wide budget cuts of 5.1 percent, known as sequestration, the intended quantity for this Invitation is reduced to 85,000 MT.

CCC will consider offers from domestic sugar processors, subject to the terms and conditions of Announcement KCPBS2, to sell sugar to CCC.

To be eligible to sell sugar to CCC, the processor must have sugar pledged as collateral for CCC loan under the Sugar Loan Program. The quantity of sugar accepted by CCC will not exceed the sugar processor's outstanding loan quantity. Title to the sugar must be free and clear of all liens and encumbrances.

CCC's cost to purchase commodities may not equal or exceed the costs associated with CCC loan forfeitures. Any offers to sell sugar to CCC at a rate equal to or higher than CCC's expected costs associated with loan forfeitures (offer cap) will be rejected and receive no additional consideration. State and regional offer caps for raw cane sugar and refined beet sugar are detailed below:

Refined Beet Sugar (basis 99.9 polarity)

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If the offer is accepted, the storing warehouse operator (processor) agrees to deliver high quality, freeflowing sugar to CCC. CCC plans to dispose of any sugar purchased through this invitation by exchanging the sugar for RSRP credits. The storing warehouse operator also agrees that receiving charges are not applicable and any storage or load out charges will not exceed rates in the Sugar Storage Agreement (SSA).

Offers for the exchanges will be analyzed, on a bulk, instore basis, for each location in conjunction with corresponding offers to sell sugar to CCC. Quantity of offers can be reduced (but not increased) up until price offers are due. CCC reserves the right to award less than the quantity offered. Conditional offers will not be considered.

Quality of the CCC purchase of raw cane sugar will be based on the IntercontinentalExchange (ICE) number 16 quality standard for polarity at 96 degrees; refined sugar quality will be based on the International Commission for Uniform Methods of Sugar Analysis (ICUMSA) quality standard for polarity at 99.9 degrees. Any sugar purchased by CCC will be exchanged, instore, basis the same quality as purchased. CCC will not be responsible for the quantity or quality of sugar delivered out of the storage facility nor for any storage or handling charges, including load out. The holders of RSRP credits will be strongly encouraged to contact warehouse operators in advance of offering to discuss the quality of sugar to be delivered, a delivery schedule, and to prearrange a schedule for premiums and discounts.

Please submit your offer on the attached Offer Form CCC-331-A. Offers (quantity, offer price, and loadout) should be submitted basis MT. For the purposes of this invitation, the conversion factor for 1 MT equals 2,204.62262 pounds. The minimum acceptable quantity per offer is 5,000 MT.

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Storage Terms

The sugar must be stored in a CCC-approved SSA facility at the time the offer is submitted. All offers must include the CCC warehouse code provided through the SSA. Although this invitation is for bulk sugar, packaged stocks (totes, bags, etc.) may be offered by the Offeror to cover their storage obligation to CCC. Packaged stocks will be considered part of the Offeror's commingled inventories and must be stored in CCC-approved space at all times. CCC maintains the right to call for delivery of its stocks at the original storage location(s) in bulk.

Charges for handling, storing, or servicing of sugar will be as follows:

Storage charges for CCC-purchased sugar will be for the account of the successful offeror through the date of title transfer from processor to CCC, and any storage payment beginning the date after title transfer is in accordance with the CCC SSA.

When CCC transfers title to its sugar instore, the handling, storage, and servicing rates applicable to the transferee with respect to such sugar shall not exceed CCC's rates in effect at the time of title transfer until the earlier of:

60 days, or

Title of the sugar is transferred by the transferee to another party, or

The sugar is loaded out of storage structure by the transferee.

The CCC rates for storage are \$0.10 per cwt per month for refined beet sugar and \$0.08 per cwt per month for raw cane sugar. The CCC rate for load out is \$0.18 per cwt for both refined beet and raw cane sugar.

Notwithstanding the above, if CCC transfers title to sugar instore, the CCC storage and handling rates will apply to such sugar until it is loaded out, provided the transferee orders, in writing, the sugar loaded out for immediate shipment, within 30 days after the date title has transferred as specified by CCC.

The successful Offeror shall at all times be responsible for maintaining the quantity and quality of sugar pledged as collateral for a CCC loan or owned by CCC until the sugar is loaded out of the facility. Since CCC bases this purchase and exchange on 96 degrees polarity for raw cane and 99.9 degrees polarity for refined beet, any differences in quality or quantity will be settled between the warehouse operator and transferee. Differences in quality or quantity on any subsequent exchange transaction will be settled between transferee and subsequent owner.
