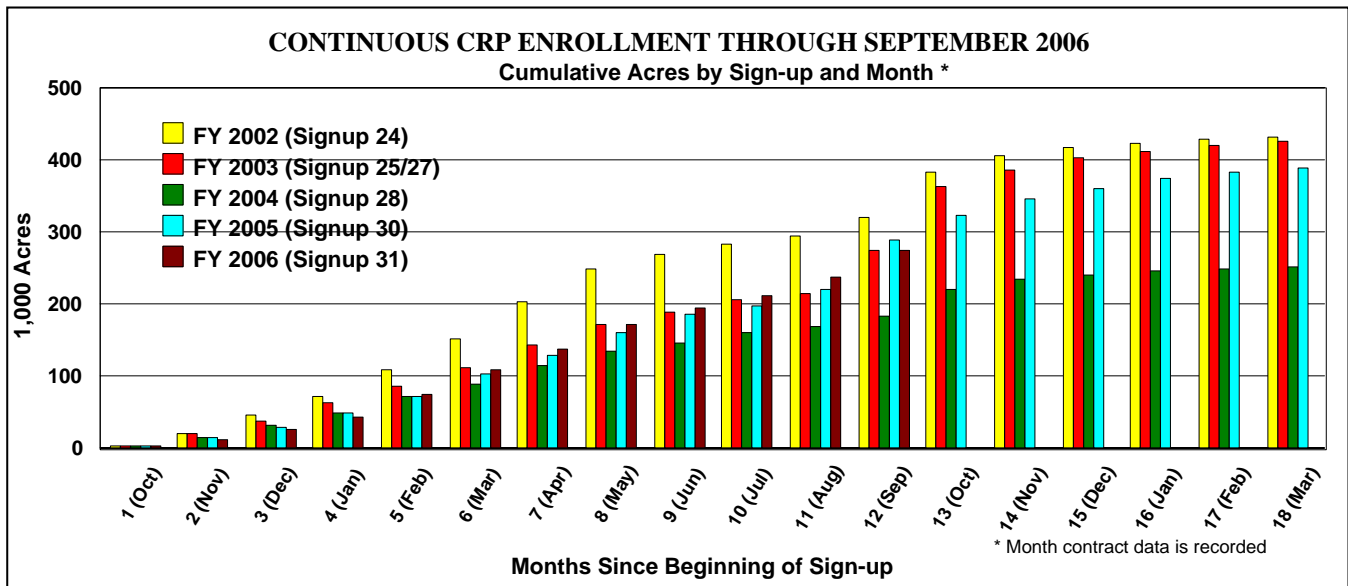

CRP ENROLLMENT ACTIVITY AND NEWS

- Since Earth Day, April 22, 2004, contracts on 162,254 acres of wetland practices (including adjacent upland buffers) have been approved. As of September 2006, wetland practice contracts (including general and continuous sign-up) total 2.03 million acres.

- FY 2006's continuous sign-up 31 is proceeding at about 4% below FY 2007's sign-up 30.
- On June 5, 2006 USDA announced preliminary results of the re-enrollment and extension (REX) offer for the 16 million acres under contracts expiring 9/30/2007. Contract-holders of about 13 million acres requested a compliance check on their contracted acres, required before acceptance of the offer.
- Holders of 12 million acres under 2008-, 2009-, and 2010-expiring contracts had until June 30, 2006 to make their request for a compliance check. A similar percentage (85%) requested the compliance check.
- The contract expiration schedule is now completely changed due to REX, and a new schedule is provided (p. 15) based on preliminary results. Actual acres expiring each year is uncertain at this time, as some contracts will be found out of compliance and other contracts may not ultimately accept the offer.
- General sign-up 33 ran March 27 through April 28, 2006. Accepted contracts will begin October 1, 2006 (FY 2007). Of the 1.4 million acres offered, about 1 million acres were accepted.

General Signup. Producers with eligible lands compete nationally for acceptance based on an environmental benefits index (EBI) during specified enrollment periods. Producers may submit offers below soil-specific maximum rental rates and select wildlife-enhancing vegetative covers to increase EBI ranking.

Continuous (Non-CREP) Sign-up. Producers with eligible lands may enroll certain high priority conservation practices, such as filter strips and riparian buffers, at any time during the year without competition. In addition to annual soil rental payment and cost-share assistance, many practices are eligible for additional annual and one-time up-front financial incentives. Land enrolled under bottomland hardwoods, floodplain and non-floodplain wetlands, and upland bird habitat (bobwhite quail buffers) initiatives are included in this category.

Conservation Reserve Enhancement Program (CREP). Under CREP agreements, Federal/State partnerships, implement projects designed to address specific environmental objectives through targeted CRP enrollments. Sign-up is held on a continuous basis, general sign-up practices may be included, and additional financial incentives are generally provided. There are 37 agreements are currently in effect in 29 States.

Farmable Wetland Program (FWP). Producers enroll small non-flood plain wetlands under modified continuous sign-up provisions.

The accompanying tables are based on contract data developed and maintained in CRP data files by USDA Service Centers through September 2006, and are based on the physical location of the CRP contracted land. Some adjustments have been made to correct mis-coded data in the active contract files. Farmable Wetland Program contracts are not included in the continuous sign-up tables.

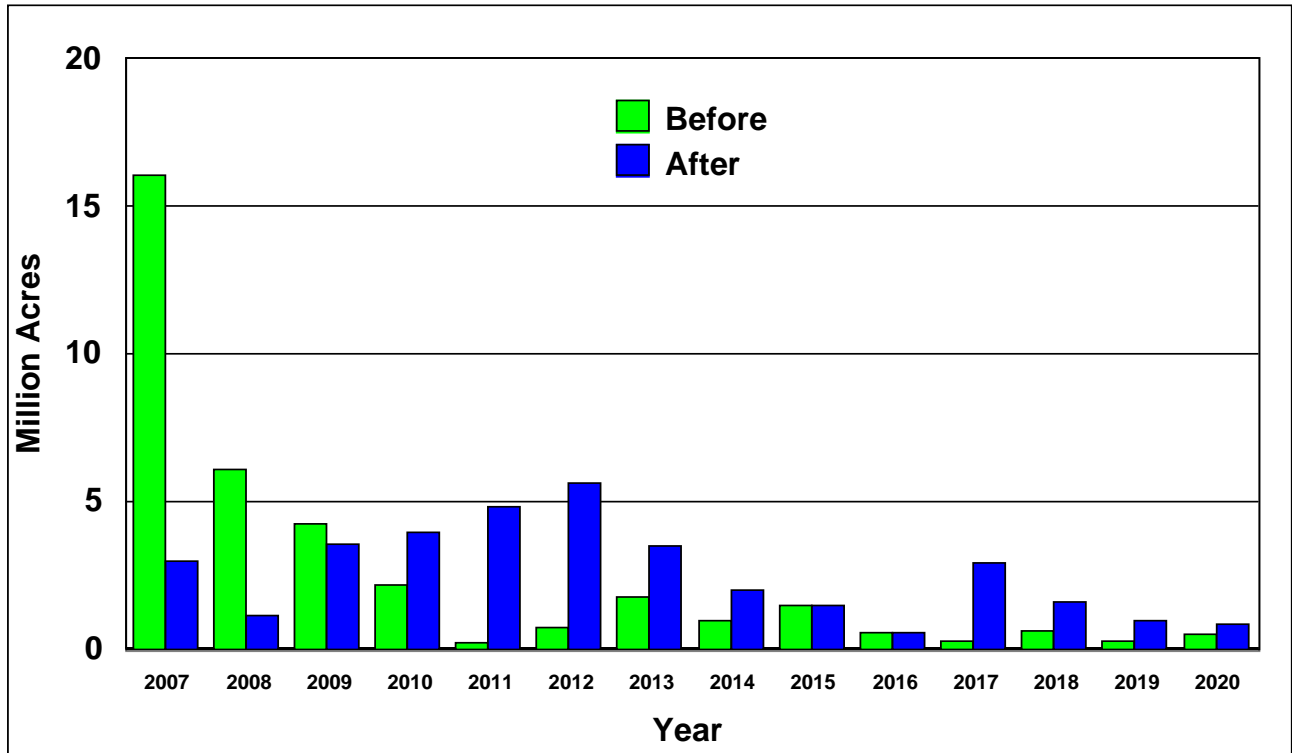
