1 Overview

A Background

All COC's and Service Centers are required to make certain there is the fair representation of underserved (racial and ethnic minority) producers in the area over which COC has jurisdiction. FSA uses the most recent NASS Census of Agriculture data to identify counties with a 10 percent or more population of racial and ethnic minority principal farm and ranch operators. The counties identified using NASS Census of Agriculture data are **required** to make an extra effort to obtain minority nominees for COC election. Both racial and ethnic minority producers will be included in all efforts to increase diversity in COC's. Minority producers and their organizations **must** be encouraged by all counties to file FSA-669A for themselves, an individual, or for a candidate of their choice.

B Purpose

This notice:

- provides a list of counties with a 10 percent or more population of racial and ethnic minority principal operators based on the NASS 2012 Census of Agriculture
- requires COC's from jurisdictions within any listed county to make an extra effort to obtain a minority candidate for the 2016 COC election.

Counties identified in Exhibit 1 were determined by using the NASS **2012** Census of Agriculture data based on minority principal operator statistics for each county in the nation.

2 Service Center Action

A FSA-669A Deadline

The deadline for all FSA-669A's is **COB August 3, 2016**.

B Requirement for an Underserved Nominee

While female nominees are encouraged, Service Centers located in a county listed in Exhibit 1 are **required** to have an ethnic **minority** nominee, based on race and/or ethnicity, **not** gender. This requirement may be waived by the State Office if there is:

- adequate documentation that the Service Center performed extensive COC election outreach with respect to racial and ethnic minority producers
- a racial and ethnic minority voting COC member currently serving whose term will carry into 2016.

If, after all efforts by COC and Service Centers are exhausted and a racial or ethnic minority candidate is not nominated, the requirement can be met by a female underserved candidate.

Alternates, minority advisors, and SDA-appointed voting members do **not** meet this requirement.

3 State Office Action and Contacts

State Offices shall ensure that each Service Center with a county listed in Exhibit 1 obtains a ethnic minority or female candidate **before** the end of the nomination period.
