1 Overview

A Background

Notice ARCPLC-14 provided the policy that current producers with an interest in the cropland on the farm may make an irrevocable program election for the following programs:

- PLC
- ARC-county coverage (ARC-CO)
- ARC-individual coverage (ARC-IC).

B Purpose

This notice:

- advises State and County Offices that the election software functionality is scheduled for release on or about **November 14, 2014**, and will provide the ability to record a:
 - farm level program election for ARC-IC
 - crop level program election for ARC-CO and PLC
- provides instructions on accessing and using the ARCPLC software for elections.

2 ARCPLC Software Access

A Introduction

The ARCPLC acreage history, yield, reallocation, and election software will all be available under the same link. Users will be able to move between each application by using the left Main Menu.

B Accessing the ARCPLC Election Software

The ARCPLC software will be available on the FSA Intranet at http://fsaintranet.sc.egov.usda.gov/fsa/applications.asp.

From the FSA Intranet Screen, under "FSA Applications" "Applications Directory", CLICK "**A C**". The FSA Intranet Screen will be redisplayed with applications with names started from A to C. Scroll down and CLICK "**ARC-PLC Election**". Users must have Level 2 eAuthentication to access.

C Security Accessibility

Access to the ARCPLC software is provided as follows.

3 ARCPLC Software Farm Selection Screen

A Overview

The Farm Selection Screen will be the starting point for components of the ARCPLC software. Users will use the Farm Selection Screen to search by farm or producer to enter the acreage history, yields, reallocation, and election applications. Clicking the appropriate link under the Main Menu allows users to navigate between applications.

6 ARCPLC Software View/Update Election Screen

A Overview

The View/Update Election Screen allows users to record the ARCPLC Program election. For the election to be recorded, a reallocation choice **must** be selected and approved for the farm.

The View/Update Election Screen is divided into the following 3 parts.

Area	Description
Crop Elections	Allows users to record the program election for each crop.
Associated Producers	Allows users to identify the producers on the farm who have an interest in the cropland.
Approval	Allows users to record the signature date for the producers and CCC representative.
