FSA State Office Comprehensive Information Management System (CIMS) Access

1 Overview

A Background

Producers have historically provided both RMA and FSA similar information to participate in the crop insurance program and farm programs.

The Farm Security and Rural Investment Act of 2002 (2002 Act), Section 10706, authorized developing CIMS to implement programs administered by RMA and FSA. The 2002 Act instructed FSA and RMA to combine, reconcile, redefine, and reformat current acreage reporting data elements to allow both agencies to use CIMS as a single source of common information.

Notice CP-642 provided that CIMS be made available to Approved Insurance Providers (AIP's) through RMA. AIP's have begun developing processes and software that allows them, their agents, and associated loss adjusters to access FSA data directly.

B Purpose

This notice informs State Offices of:

- the schedule of access to the CIMS Application and User Guide
- reports accessible as determined by logins
- known discrepancies between RMA and FSA data.

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2 CIMS Data

A Overview

CIMS incorporates multiple data sources and organizes them into reports allowing users to easily ensure accuracy, quality assurance, and timeliness in the data collected between agencies. Data is uploaded to CIMS on a weekly basis.

CIMS also provides a tool that may be helpful to State and County Offices as they review and process information required for the SURE Program. It allows users to mine acreage report data as needed.

B Discrepancies

In some cases the data or processes may not match between agencies because of current differences between existing policy and procedures. CIMS makes every attempt to resolve these issues when possible.

The following are some known discrepancies that may be found when using CIMS.

- CIMS data is based on processed RMA and FSA data from the previous week.
- The refresh CIMS Load Date will mostly differ between FSA and RMA because of different data conversion processes required for CIMS compatibility. Refresh dates for both agencies should be within the same week.
- RMA acreage is net acres, which are reported acres adjusted by the insured's share.
- RMA data is only for crops that have been insured through the crop insurance program.
- RMA data for nursery, aquaculture, livestock, and adjusted gross revenue are not included at this time.
- FSA and RMA crop tables may be different from the crop categorization table that CIMS references. This could result in some crops not showing up in some reports until it is added to the crop categorization table. CIMS User Guide, Exhibit 1 provides a translation table.

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2 CIMS Data (Continued)

B Discrepancies (Continued)

- FSA and RMA may not use the same county name, designation, or code. CIMS User Guide, Exhibit 2 provides a translation table.
- RMA data is based on producer location county; FSA data is based on administrative county.
- FSA and RMA have different codes for business/entity type. CIMS User Guide, Exhibit 3 provides a translation table.
- FSA and RMA have crops where RMA Reinsurance Year does not correspond to FSA Program/Crop Year. CIMS User Guide, Exhibit 11 provides a translation table.

3 Schedule for CIMS

A State Office Users

FSA State Office users will have access to CIMS, which includes a User Guide, through the URL <https://extranet4.rma.usda.gov/apps/cims/>.

- Users will access CIMS using their eAuthentication login.
- State Offices will be granted access on or about November 17, 2009.
- After accessing CIMS users should print the User Guide to help navigate through the application.

B County Office Users

County Office users will begin gaining access to CIMS after State Office access is complete. Because of the vast number of County Office users, access will be granted using a 3 phase approach. A forthcoming notice will provide further guidance and the timeline for this process.

The following CIMS reports will be accessible to FSA State Office users:

- Participation Summary
- Producer Crop/Acreage
- CIMS Report of FSA Commodities
- SURE RMA Data.

Note: The SURE RMA data may not initially appear in the Reports Menu.

B County Office CIMS Reports Access

The following reports will be accessible to FSA County Office users:

- Participation Summary
- Producer Crop/Acreage
- SURE RMA Data.
