1 **Overview**

A Background

On October 1, 2014, offer enrollment for signup 47 began. State and County Offices were informed through Information Bulletins 7205 and 7205R that continuous CRP signup 47 (State Acres for Wildlife Enhancement (SAFE) and highly erodible land initiative offers were exempt) offers could be submitted in the Conservation Online System (COLS), but the offers could not be COC approved in COLS until further notice.

B Purpose

This notice informs State and County Offices that:

upon manual AGI verification that the proper documentation has been received, continuous CRP signup 47 offers may be COC approved in COLS

Note: All requirements in 2-CRP, paragraph 401 must be met before COC may approve CRP-1.

- upon manual verification that the FY 2015 AGI requirements have been met, payments • calculated as a result of the COC approval of continuous CRP signup 47 offers can be certified and signed in NPS
- a temporary software modification has been implemented in COLS to allow COC approval of continuous CRP signup 47 offers, but with these mandatory actions as required by State and County Offices
- the FY 2015 AGI check for \$900,000 has been temporarily disabled •

Note: COLS will temporarily bypass this AGI validation, thereby allowing all continuous CRP signup 47 offers to be COC approved.

2 Mandatory Action

A Before Entering COC Approval for Continuous CRP Signup 47 Offers in COLS

Before entering the COC approval for continuous CRP signup 47 offers in COLS, COC and designees shall ensure that every producer on the offer with a share greater than 0 percent files CCC-941 for FY 2015. If the producer is an entity or joint operation, then all members shall also file CCC-941.
