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1 Overview

A Background

Historically, FSA has used contracting options to have vendors (contract appraisers) provide appraisals for determining the value of real estate or chattel security for loan making or loan servicing actions. 1-FLP, Part 7, Amendment 117 has been revised to streamline the process for FLP PLCE expenses, including appraisal services.

FSA will use Micropurchase authority under the Simplified Acquisition Method of the Federal Acquisition Regulations (FAR) to obtain goods and services at, or below, the Micropurchase limit directly without the assistance of a Contracting Officer (CO). Cost items that exceed the Micropurchase limit will be required to follow the contractual requirements of the FAR and procurement of those goods and services will be handled by CO's.

Many States are using Blanket Purchase Agreement (BPA) purchase orders as the contractual method to obtain appraisal services. The BPA may have a specified period of performance under the agreement. Therefore, using the streamlined procurement process for appraisal services will be implemented using a phased approach as provided in this notice.

B Purpose

This notice provides guidance:

- about implementing the streamlined process to obtain appraisal services
- for when a state may implement the streamline procurement process to obtain appraisal services
- on obtaining the authority to implement the streamline procurement process to obtain appraisal services.

2 Implementing Streamlined Processes to Obtain Appraisal Services

A Continued Use of Current Appraisal Services Process

States that have a BPA or other existing processes to obtain appraisal services shall continue to use their current methodology. The conversion to the streamlined processes established in 1-FLP, Part 7 shall be implemented according to subparagraph B.

B Obtaining Approval to Implement Streamlined Processes

States shall obtain guidance on implementing the streamlined processes to obtain appraisal services according to the following table.
