# 1 Approving FSFL's

## A Background

FSFL policy requires that an approved credit decision be completed in FBP before FSFL can be approved in DLS.

The FBP credit action decision of "approved" or "disapproved" **must** be updated on the **same day** as the COC/STC meeting to ensure that the producer receives the correct FSFL interest rate.

When the FBP credit action decision is **not** updated on the same day, FSFL cannot be correctly approved in DLS. The National Office has received many requests to correct the COC/STC approval date in DLS because of monthly FSFL interest rate changes. In most cases, FSFL approval is delayed and a help desk remedy ticket is required.

**Note:** 2-FSFL, Part 4 and 1-FLP, Exhibit 15 provide additional guidance for FBP and DLS FSFL approvals.

This notice informs State and County Offices of required actions on the day of the COC/STC meeting.

# 1 Approving FSFL's (Continued)

## **D** Action

County Offices **must** ensure that on the day of the COC/STC meeting an FSA employee with loan approval authority:

- is made aware of the scheduled COC/STC meeting
- is available on the day of the COC/STC meeting to update FBP
- updates the credit decision to "approved" or "disapproved".

**Note:** If the initial FSA employee with loan approval authority who entered the FBP credit presentation and/or decision is **not** available, another FSA employee with loan approval authority is authorized to update the credit decision status.
