# **Announcing 2012 SURE**

#### 1 Overview

## A Background

The Food, Conservation, and Energy Act of 2008 (Pub. L. 110-246), as amended, authorizes the SURE Program ending with losses occurring because of weather events through September 30, 2011. SURE is available to eligible producers on farms:

- in counties with Secretarial disaster declarations, including contiguous counties, that have incurred at least a 10 percent crop production or quality loss, or both, for at least 1 crop of economic significance, **except** grazed crops
- on which the actual production on the farm is less than 50 percent of the farm's normal production.

### **B** Purpose

This notice:

- identifies State and County Office action to prepare for 2012 SURE Program signup
- reiterates that **all** SURE eligibility provisions, including the risk management purchase requirement (RMPR), apply to the producer and crops of economic significance.

#### C Program Signup Dates

Signup for the SURE Program for 2012 crop losses is scheduled to begin in May. A forthcoming notice will announce the signup dates.

## **D** SURE Payments

An information bulletin will be issued when 2012 payment software is available. See 1-SURE for instructions on entering payments and 1-CM for instructions on common payment reports.

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# 2 Qualifying Loss for SURE Farm Eligibility

## **A SURE Qualifying Loss**

The 2008 Farm Bill and regulations (7 CFR Part 760, Subpart G) specify that, to receive SURE payments, an eligible producer on a SURE farm **must** have a qualifying loss. A qualifying loss is defined as a loss of 10 percent or more on at least 1 crop of economic significance because of disaster on a farm that is either:

- located in a disaster county
- if not located in any disaster county or county contiguous to such a county, but has an overall loss greater than or equal to 50 percent of normal production on the farm (expected revenue for all crops on the farm) because of disaster.

**Notes:** SURE farms include all crop acreage in all counties that a producer planted or intended to plant for harvest for normal commercial sale or farm livestock feeding.

A crop of economic significance is a crop that contributes at least 5 percent of the expected revenue for a producer's SURE farm.

A disaster county is a county for which a Secretarial disaster designation has been issued, or a county contiguous to a county with a Secretarial disaster designation. The disaster designation **must** be effective for the crop year for which SURE payments are being applied.

# **B** Additional Qualifying Loss Requirements for 2012 SURE

At the time of filing the 2012 FSA-682, the producer will be **required** to identify and certify the crop or crops of economic significance on the SURE farm that suffered the 10 percent loss because of disaster occurring through September 30, 2011.

**Note:** Crops are **not** required to be harvested by September 30, 2011, to maintain eligibility for SURE. Rather, the applicant must identify the crop or crops that suffered a loss because of disaster occurring through September 30, 2011.

COC shall ensure that the economically significant 2012 crop or crops certified as having the 10 percent qualifying loss because of a disaster occurring through September 30, 2011, meet all the following criteria, as applicable:

- for insured crops, the insurance policy defines the coverage period as beginning before October 1, 2011
- for NAP crops, the coverage period begins **before** October 1, 2011
- the final planting date, according to RMA and FSA for NAP crops **only**, occurred **before** October 1, 2011.

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### **2** Qualifying Loss for SURE Farm Eligibility (Continued)

### **B** Additional Qualifying Loss Requirements for 2012 SURE (Continued)

FSA **must** be satisfied that the claimed loss of at least 1 nonexcepted crop on the SURE farm was because of disaster occurring through September 30, 2011, to determine that a qualifying loss has triggered.

# C Researching 2012 Crops Coverage Periods and Final Planting Dates

State Offices shall assist County Offices in researching coverage periods and final planting dates for 2012 crops using available data sources including:

- NCT's
- RMA web sites.

**Notes:** The date coverage actually began for a specific producer will be used for COC determinations on qualifying losses.

Producers shall be encouraged to file 2012 FSA-682 and County Offices shall **not** use eligibility criteria to discourage producers from filing.

#### 3 Action

#### **A State Office Action**

State Offices shall:

- follow subparagraph 2 C to assist County Offices in researching crop coverage periods and final planting dates
- establish 2012 SURE crop data according to 1-SURE, Part 3
- load STC-approved data into the 2012 NCT according to 1-NAP, Part 10, Section 1.5.

### **B** County Office Action

County Offices shall follow subparagraph 2 C to research crop coverage periods and final planting dates in conjunction with the State Office.

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
