1 Overview

A Background

FY 2004 fund codes were issued in County Software Release No. 525.

B Purpose

This notice informs county offices of the FY 2004 EQIP primary and supplemental fund codes.

2 FY 2004 Fund Codes

A Primary Fund Codes

Primary fund codes shall be the first fund code used when a CCC-1200 is created. If a contract will be funded 100 percent by only one fund code, use a primary fund code. Following are FY 2004 primary fund codes:

- 402222/2004 – Ground and Surface Water Conservation
- 409999/2004 – Basic EQIP

B Supplemental Fund Codes

Supplemental fund codes can only be used as the second or later fund code on a CCC-1200. The following is the FY 2004 supplemental fund code:

- 408222/2004 – Ground and Surface Water Conservation

A producer that desires to apply for a basic EQIP practice(s) and complete a water conservation practice(s) on a farm would have a CCC-1200 that reflects a primary fund code of 409999/2004 and a supplemental fund code of 408222/2004.

- County offices shall make applicable fund codes in paragraph 2 eligible on the CCC County Eligibility Table according to 2-CONSV, paragraph 14.
- Enter all FY 2004 manually processed CCC-1200's, if any, in the system according to 2-CONSV, Part. 3.

B FY 2004 EQIP Applications Entered in the System 36 with FY 2003 Fund Codes

FY 2004 EQIP applications that have been entered in the system with 2003 fund codes will need to be updated to reflect the new fund codes in paragraph 2 using the "Update CCC-1200" option.
