

Presidential Major Disaster Declaration M1465

1 Overview

A Background

On May 10, 2003, President Bush declared a Major disaster in Oklahoma based on damages and losses caused by severe storms and tornadoes that occurred from May 8, 2003 and continuing. As a result of this major disaster, nine Oklahoma counties were named as primary and are declared eligible for Federal disaster assistance, including FSA emergency (EM) loans for eligible family farmers. Those counties are:

Also, in accordance with section 321(a) of the Consolidated Farm and Rural Development Act, counties that are contiguous to a primary county will be named as contiguous disaster counties where eligible family farmers may qualify for FSA EM loan assistance. Contiguous Oklahoma counties in this disaster declaration are:

### 2 Action

#### A Determining Security Values

For the purpose of determining loan security values for loan applications, the beginning date of the incidence period is May 8, 2003.

#### B District Director Responsibility

The District Director will closely monitor compliance to meet the requirements of Section 1945.20(a)(3) of FmHA Instruction 1945-A.

#### C Public Announcements

Special emphasis will be placed on informing the farm community through public announcements and arranging and conducting meetings with local agricultural lenders and leaders.

### 3 Filing Instructions

#### A FLP Series

This notice will be filed in chronological order with FLP series notices, and a copy of this notice will be filed preceding FmHA Instruction 1945-A and FmHA Instruction 1924-B.

#### B Operation Filing

A file will be established in the Farm Loan Office's operational file for each disaster designation. The file will contain a copy of this notice and documentation to support compliance with the requirements of Section 1945.20(1)(3). This file will be labeled, "Presidential Major Disaster Declaration M1465," filed, maintained, and disposed of in accordance with Handbook 25-AS, exhibit 40.5.
