2001/2002 LAP Payment Limitation for Combined State Producers

1 Overview

A Background

All State agencies, divisions, or political subdivisions that receive tax revenue support or that have taxing authority are combined as one “person” for payment limitation purposes according to 1-PL, paragraph 256.

If this combined entity exceeds the applicable limitation of LAP payments, a drawing shall be conducted by the control county (State Office) to determine the order of payment. In order to determine if the limitation will be exceeded, the State Office must be notified of the potential payments.

B Purpose

The purposes of this notice are to:

- remind County Offices of the procedure in 1-PL (Rev. 1), Paragraph 256, concerning the rules for State agencies, divisions, and political subdivisions
- provide a list of known entities included in the combined state producer
- provide County Offices with a specific date by which to submit LAP payment information for the combined state producers.

2 Action

A County Office Action

All counties where an entity included in the combined state producer applied for LAP shall submit a copy of the computer generated “Application for 2001 or 2002 Livestock Assistance Program” to the Compliance Section no later than December 10. The State Office will conduct the drawing.
