SUBJECT: Credit Report Service

TO: State Directors, District Directors, and County Supervisors

ATTENTION: Rural Housing Chiefs

PURPOSE/INTENDED OUTCOME:

The purpose of this Administrative Notice (AN) is to provide guidance on ordering credit reports after July 31, 1990. The intended effect is to have field offices order credit reports primarily from Credit Bureau Reports, Inc. (CBR) and on a limited basis from Equifax Services Inc. (Equifax).

COMPARISON WITH PREVIOUS AN:

This AN replaces AN No. 2081 (1910), dated April 26, 1990, which authorized the ordering of credit reports only from CBR.

IMPLEMENTATION RESPONSIBILITIES:

The General Services Administration has concluded their credit report service negotiations with Equifax and has awarded a contract to them. Therefore, effective July 31, 1990, FmHA County Offices are authorized to order credit reports from both CBR and Equifax.

In accordance with FmHA Instruction 1910-B Exhibit A, when an FmHA field office is serviced by one or more contractors that provides equal or similar credit information, the contractor supplying the credit report at the least cost will be used. This, in most cases, will be CBR.
