1 Overview

**A
Background**

The Arkansas State FSA Office has received notice from the National Office that the spring-seeded crop reporting date for Arkansas has been extended due to record amounts of rainfall received during the month of June that delayed crop planting in many areas in Arkansas.

**B
Purpose**

The purpose of this notice is to advise counties that:

- The July 15th spring-seeded crop reporting date for Arkansas has been extended to **August 1st** for the **2004 Crop Year ONLY**.

County Offices shall:

- Immediately publicize by all means of communication the extension date for spring-seeded crops
- Remind producers of the requirement to report NAP crops timely as follows:
 - the earlier of the established reporting date for spring-seeded crops (August 1st) or 15 days before the onset of harvest or grazing
