Emergency loan applications will be received through September 9, 2004, and applications pending on that date may be processed and completed. EM loans will be made under 3-FLP Direct Loan Making.

Also, for the purpose of establishing security values as set forth in 3-FLP, paragraph 171 when determining loan security values for loan applications, the beginning date of the incidence period is August 3, 2003.

Farmers in the disaster area's have until September 9, 2004 to apply for the loans to help cover part of their actual losses. To be eligible, producers must have suffered at least a 30-percent loss of normal production in a single enterprise, be able to repay the loan and any other loans, be unable to obtain credit elsewhere, and have adequate security.
