1 Overview

A Purpose

The Arkansas State Committee has established deadlines for requesting applications for NAP coverage. County Offices are to ensure all application closing dates are publicized in accordance with provisions of 1-NAP (Rev. 1), paragraph 23 D. Exhibit 1 provides 2005 NAP application closing dates.

2 County Office Action

A County Office Responsibilities

County Offices shall publicize all application closing dates using local media (newspaper, farm magazines, radio, etc.), town hall meetings, newsletters, and any other available source.

Be aware the CCC-471 provides continuous coverage and will remain in effect for each crop year following acceptance of the original CCC-471 unless the producer elects or fails to timely pay the administrative fee before the application closing date.

County Offices shall notify producers of the applicable service fee determined on the basis of the previous crop year coverage and include payment due date. Provide producers a summary of continuing coverage, including instructions for deleting or adding eligible crops. Reference 1-NAP (Rev. 1), paragraph 23 E for continuous coverage provisions.
