The information will be used to complete the terms of an agreement between the 501(c)(3) organization and the Commodity Credit Corporation (CCC). Furnishing the requested information is voluntary; however, without it, eligibility to enter into an agreement with CCC cannot be determined. This agreement is entered into by the 501(c)(3) organization and the Commodity Credit Corporation (CCC) in order to implement the Farm Service Agency's 501(c)(3) National Nonprofit Humanitarian Initiative Agreement. CCC will donate CCC-owned Nonfat Dry Milk (NDM) to nonprofit organizations to help feed the hungry in the United States of America (domestic use only).

The term "nonprofit organization" means an incorporated or unincorporated entity that is operating for religious, charitable, or educational purposes, and does not provide net earnings to or operate in any other manner that inures to the benefit of any officer, employee, or shareholder of the entity - as defined in the Child Nutrition Act of 1966, Section 22, USC 42 USC 1791, Bill Emerson Good Samaritan Food Donation Act, Pub. L. 104-210, and Title 26, CFR §1.501(c)(3) -1 Organizations organized and operated exclusively for one of more of the following purposes: religious, charitable, scientific, etc.

CCC will donate two types of NDM: (1) non-fortified NDM, and (2) instantized, NDM, fortified with vitamins A and D, to qualified national nonprofit organizations to assist in food relief without restrictions to needy recipients.

PART A - ORGANIZATION REQUIREMENTS (In order to qualify and sign up as an Eligible Organization, an organization must, as determined where appropriate by CCC, satisfy the following requirements):

1. Organization requirements are:
 - A. Provide a copy of its 501(c)(3) tax-exempt status letter issued by the Internal Revenue Service, (26 CFR §1.501(c)(3) -1), in order to document that it is a nonprofit, tax-exempt charitable organization.
 - B. Provide a copy of the organization's most recent required IRS Form 990.
 - C. Provide a clear and concise written plan for product distribution, product tracking and outline of use.
 - D. Possess the management capacity to effectively execute the distribution plan and full reporting requirements. (See Part A, Paragraph 2F.)
 - E. Provide measurable results / outcomes. (See Part A, Paragraph 2F.)

The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) prohibits discrimination in all its programs and activities on the basis of race, color, national origin, gender, religion, age, disability, political beliefs, sexual orientation, and marital or family status. (Not all prohibited bases apply to all programs.) 2. Submit a Letter of Inquiry to sign up that provides the following information:
 - A. Cover letter.
 - B. Applicant's name, address, telephone number, FAX number and E-mail address.
 - C. Names of officers, owners, and / or partners.
 - D. Secondary organizations (network, affiliates, and / or secondary organizations to which the primary organization applicant will provide NDM to distribute to the needy).
 - E. Organizational history.
 - F. Clear, concise plan for product distribution, product tracking and outline of use (including target population, objectives, and outcome measures), and
 - G. Signed Agreement (See Part E, Page 4 of this Agreement).

PART B - POLICY AND PROCEDURES FOR QUALIFIED NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS

CCC will approve organizations to receive NDM directly from CCC. Qualified primary organizations must comply with the following requirements:

1. The NDM cannot be resold, exchanged, bartered, used as an ingredient for further processing into another commercial product, or exported to other countries. The NDM must be distributed in the U.S.
2. Persons receiving NDM, or meals containing it, must not be required to participate in any religious or political discussions or activities.
3. Persons receiving NDM, or meals containing it, cannot be charged any fee for it, and cannot be asked to make a voluntary contribution in connection with receipt.
4. Nonprofit organizations currently receiving NDM as a donated product from the U.S. Department of Agriculture, Food and Nutrition Service (FNS), under the Emergency Food Assistance Program (TEFAP) may also receive NDM from organizations under this agreement.
5. The qualified primary organization shall place all orders for NDM under this agreement with the Kansas City Commodity Office (KCCO), per instructions in Part D in this agreement. Secondary organizations must not contact the FSA or KCCO.
6. Following the first month's delivery, an organization must submit a Distribution Record Report to KCCO. The record report must reflect that the organization has distributed and tracked 50 percent of previously delivered NDM before an organization can receive additional ordered quantities. (See Part A, Paragraph 2F.)
7. USDA may make unannounced visits to any qualified primary organization, and secondary organization, at any time, for any reason related to activities under this agreement.
8. Any activity regarding the use of CCC - provided NDM that may result in a conflict of interest, whether factual or perceived, is subject to inquiry by CCC.
9. Primary and secondary organizations must distribute NDM, or use it for congregate meal service received under this agreement in a timely manner to ensure that NDM is not left in storage for prolonged periods.
10. Primary and secondary organizations shall store and handle the NDM in full compliance with applicable Federal, State and local health and food safety requirements, and in a manner that will preserve its condition.

PART C - PROVISION OF NDM

1. CCC will donate and deliver NDM to the qualified primary organizations in truckload(s), for use in feeding needy families and individuals.
2. CCC will deliver the NDM to the location(s) specified on the Order Form CCC-330A. **A separate order form must be submitted for delivery to each destination.** Recipients must order a minimum of one truckload per order form. (Order Form CCC-330A may be duplicated.) Various NDM products and pack sizes CANNOT be combined in a truckload. One truckload must have same type of product and package size. Recipient organizations may not alter originally designated delivery destinations.
3. Types and pack sizes of NDM:
Orders must be placed in full truckload quantities. Deliveries will not be made to any destination in less than a full truckload.
 - A. NDM - Non-fortified - 25 kg bags. Truckload Qty: 41,336 lbs. / 750 bags. (Non-fortified is recommended for cooking and baking. Although it can be mixed with water for drinking, it does not dissolve well and may be lumpy.)
 - B. NDM - Non-fortified - 12 / 2 lb. bags. Truckload Qty: 33,264 lbs. / 1,386 cases. (Non-fortified is recommended for cooking and baking. Although it can be mixed with water for drinking, it does not dissolve well and may be lumpy.)
 - C. NDM - (Instant) - Fortified with vitamins A and D - 12 / 25.6 oz. bags. Truckload Qty: 26,880 lbs. / 1,400 cases. (NDM Instantized and fortified with vitamins A and D is primarily used for drinking. It is prepared by mixing with water.)
 - D. NDM - (Instant) - Fortified with vitamins A and D - 6 / 4 lb. cartons or bags. Truckload Qty: 31,104 lbs. / 1,296 cases. (NDM Instantized and fortified with vitamins A and D is primarily used for drinking. It is prepared by mixing with water.)
4. The NDM provided is for human consumption and conforms in all respects to Federal and State government regulations. All NDM received will be from a USDA-approved facility. Any NDM over 180 days old will be tested by CCC before the NDM is delivered to guarantee the quality of U.S. Extra Grade. Additional information about NDM can be located at the following websites:

3. KCCO will notify the qualified organization via FAX that the NDM order has been accepted.

- 1. Any violation of the terms of this agreement may result in termination of the agreement. CCC reserves the right to discontinue the distribution of any NDM to any qualified organization and / or secondary organization at any time.
- 2. FSA assumes no liability for acts committed by employees of the organization.
