**Posting Hay  
“Need/Have” Ads**

Producers with internet access can post hay “need/have” ads on the FSA HayNet by taking the following steps:

1. Access the FSA Home page at [www.FSA.usda.gov](http://www.FSA.usda.gov)
2. Select the “HayNet” quick link
3. Select the “Need Hay” or “Have Hay” item
4. Select “Oklahoma” or state producer is located in
5. Select “Place an Ad”
6. Complete the information page
7. Select “submit”

The ad will then be placed on the internet FSA HayNet site for the specified state.

**Publicizing**

All County Executive Directors shall publicize the availability of the FSA HayNet site in county newsletters, newspapers, and radio (all available services).

**Note:** Publicity of the FSA HayNet shall be made in all counties regardless of whether they have CRP acreage. The site is to assist producers in locating hay, due to the drought conditions in portions of the United States.
