**Actions for Contracting CRP Signup 26 Offers**

**1 Overview**

**A Background**

The Secretary of Agriculture announced August 25, 2003, acceptance of 2 million acres in CRP. A total of 4.1 million acres were offered. Oklahoma had 44,220 acres accepted in CRP from the 78,686.8 acres offered.

Notice CRP-443 announced CRP signup 26 selection process and provided counties guidance on accepting and rejecting offers. Signup 26 was the first to process all offers "in-house" by FSA. NRCS, or the Technical Service Provider (TSP), remains responsible for the technical aspect of CRP in developing plans on acceptable offers. FSA will need to convey all necessary information to NRCS, or the TSP, in order that a Conservation Plan of Operation (CPO) can be developed to reflect the EBI points that led to acceptance, and that the participant committed to, on the CRP-2 and CRP-1.

**B Purpose**

This notice provides additional information for processing signup 26 offers and information to provide NRCS for development of the CPO.

**2 Providing Information to NRCS**

**A Acceptable and Rejected Offer Report**

The CED shall provide the CRP Signup 26 Acceptable and Rejected Offer Report to the local NRCS DC. Access the report according to Notice CRP-443, subparagraph 3 A.

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**2 Providing Information to NRCS (continued)**

**B CRP-2 Data**

To develop the CPO, provide NRCS a copy of the CRP-2 on all eligible accepted offers. Highlight items 1, 3, 11A, 11B, 11C, and 11D. Additionally, write "GUZZLER" in blank area of Item 11, if the producer specified that a wildlife guzzler would be installed on the offered acreage.

**C List of CRP Participants on the CRP-1**

Provide NRCS a list of all CRP participants applicable to each individual acceptable offer in order that NRCS can obtain all required signatures on the CPO. Identify the farm and tract number on the list and attach this list to the CRP-2 described in subparagraph 2 C.

**D Aerial Photocopy of Acceptable Acreage**

The CRP-2 does not describe the actual legal location of the acres on the acceptable offer. Provide NRCS an aerial photocopy of each individual acceptable offer boldly highlighting the specific acceptable CRP acreage. Attach the aerial photocopy to the CRP-2 described in subparagraph 2 C.

**3 COF Activities on Acceptable and Rejected Offers**

**A Acceptable and Rejected Offer List Review and Potential Errors**

The CRP Signup 26 Acceptable and Rejected Offer Report shall be reviewed according to Notice CRP-443, subparagraph 3 B. A second party review of the **all** eligibility requirements and maximum payment rate calculations is required, according to 2-CRP (Rev. 4), subparagraph 253 A. If offer information, EBI factor, or subfactor information is incorrect, and requires recalculation for a possible acceptable or rejected offer, submit the case file to the STO for review and action to approve or disapprove the correction. Producers shall not be informed of their offer status, if an error was discovered until after the STO review is completed. These cases shall be immediately forwarded by expedited delivery to the STO, due to the short contracting timeframe.

**B Acceptable Offer Notification**

Notify producers with acceptable offers by utilizing the CRP-23 in Exhibit 12 of 2-CRP (Rev. 4). Change the wording in the CRP-23 from 30 days to 15 days, as the number of days the producer has to inform the COF of whether or not they want to continue with the offer. The shorter notification period is necessary, since all contracting on a CRP-1 must be completed and approved in the System 36 by September 30, 2003.

Producers are not required to notify the COF in writing. A participant's response shall be noted in the CRP folder.

**3 COF Activities on Acceptable and Rejected Offers (Continued)**

**B Acceptable Offer Notification (Continued)**

Liquidated damages apply to acceptable offers that are withdrawn and to those where the participant did not respond to the COF within 15 days.

**C Rejected Offers**

Notify producers with rejected offers by utilizing the CRP-26 in Exhibit 12 of 2-CRP (Rev. 4). Modify the CRP-26 to include appropriate appeal rights according to 1-APP. If the COF notifies the producers without reviewing the acceptable and rejected offer list with the COC, then the decision is a county office employee decision with appeal rights to the COC. If the CED is able to review the list with the COC, then the decision is a COC decision, and the participant shall be offered reconsideration to the COC, mediation or appeal to the STC or NAD.

**D Change of Effective Date**

Changing of the acceptable offer effective date from October 1, 2003, to October 1, 2004, or vice versa, has not been authorized. The effective date the producer selected during the offer period will remain.

**E Conservation Plan of Operation (CPO)**

The CPO shall reflect the required items in 2-CRP (Rev. 4), subparagraph 236 B. A checklist for CPO content is contained in Exhibit 1. The CRP-1 shall not be approved without a properly completed CPO.

The CRP-2 may contain practices with different contract lengths in Item 11D. At the time of offer, counties were to complete separate CRP-1s for practices with different contract lengths on the CRP-2. NRCS may develop one CPO for tracts that have practices with different contract lengths. In these situations, the CPO shall be copied and attached to each CRP-1 associated with the multi-length contract practices on the CRP-2.

All CPOs must be completed by September 26, 2003.

**F NRCS Field Visit**

NRCS will make a field visit to each accepted CRP offer to develop the CPO. The field visit may reveal a cover or situation that is different than what the producer provided on the CRP-2. NRCS will bring these situations to the attention of the CED for resolution.

**3 COF Activities on Acceptable and Rejected Offers (Continued)**

**G COC Approval**

The COC shall approve all eligible CRP-1s by September 30, 2003. All information necessary for contracting must be on the CRP-2, CRP-1, and CPO prior to COC approval. Exhibit 1 also contains a checklist of items to be completed prior to COC approval of the CRP-1. Exhibit 1 shall be completed for COC review prior to the CRP-1 approval.

Acceptable offers will not be approved after September 30, 2003. CEDs shall arrange COC meetings or additional meetings for timely approval of eligible CRP-1s.

**H OK Amendment to 2-CRP (Rev. 4)**

The OK Amendment to 2-CRP (Rev. 4) should be distributed to counties the first part of September.
