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

1 Overview

A Background

The Oregon FSA has completed its upgrade into the digital imagery. Each county has old digitizing equipment that was used with the paper photo maps. This equipment is no longer needed.

A Excess and Surplus

County offices are advised to read all of 31-AS Part 4, Section 5 to make sure they understand the process.

In Accordance With handbook 31-AS Real Property, Personal Property, and Motor Vehicle Management Part 4, Section 5, Par 227 Donating Property, the county office will try to donate the equipment consisting of the Planimeter, Numonics Model 1200S, 1200H and the digitizing table to the authorized donees in Par 227 C. If an organization is found that would like the equipment the county office must complete Par 227 B for approval.

If no organization is found that would like the equipment the county offices are authorize to use Par 228 to abandon the equipment.

B Time Line

The county offices should do this as soon as possible. All county offices have until 12/1/04 to complete this task.
