

Background

The President has signed a fourth Continuing Resolution for FY 2002 that is effective through November 16, 2001. The Senate has passed a regular USDA appropriations bill for FY 2002. A conference committee must now meet to resolve differences between the House and Senate passed versions of the bill. It is hoped that final action on a conference agreement can be completed before the expiration of the fourth CR.

- Review anticipated expenditures. The STO must be notified at once if you anticipate a shortfall before additional funds are allocation. Please continue to be fiscally responsible the STO should be notified of any unusual expenditure that might be occurring during the next few weeks.
