

1 Overview

A Purpose

To provide COFs with revised FY2001 EQIP allocations and revised fund codes.

B Background

The Oregon State NRCS office obtained additional EQIP funds for FY 2001.

The additional EQIP dollars was allocated to COF through OR CONOP Notice 16.

Recently, WDC has notified STO that the additional EQIP funds needs to be reduced by .22%. The reduction will come from the Statewide Resource Concern dollars.

The recent download of 2001 EQIP GPA fund codes does not correspond to those issued to COFs in OR CONOP Notice 16.

2 Resource Concerns (RC)

A

Resource Concern Allocation

Resource Concern (RC) funds are intended to assist producers, located outside the Geographic Priority Areas, with implementation of conservation practices.

RC Funds will be kept in a reserve account in STO and allocated to COFs as needed.

RC are allocated as follows:

The STO will allocate RC funds as requested by COFs.
