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SUBJECT: Farmer Program Dwelling Retention

TO: All State Directors, Farmer Program Chiefs,  
District Directors, and County Supervisors, FmHA

PURPOSE/INTENDED OUTCOME

The purpose of this administrative notice is to emphasize what inventory property will be considered for dwelling retention.

IMPLEMENTATION RESPONSIBILITIES

FmHA Instruction 1955-B, Section 1955.73, provides that, to be considered for dwelling retention, the property must have been acquired as a result of foreclosure by FmHA, a voluntary conveyance, or a conveyance to the Government by a Trustee in bankruptcy. Property acquired as a result of a foreclosure by another creditor where FmHA bids at the sale or exercises redemption rights will not be considered for dwelling retention unless FmHA joined in the foreclosure.
