Purpose/Intended Outcome To realign hearing officers for Arizona and New Mexico and make corrections in a telephone number for the Indianapolis Area Office.

Comparison with Previous AN This AN supercedes AN 1784 (1900) dated August 15, 1988, which should be removed.

Implementation Responsibilities Effective immediately, appeal requests from Arizona and New Mexico will be handled by the Denver Area Office. All notification of appeal rights from these two States will now name the Area Supervisor, NAS, Denver. No action is required for those appeals already in process.

The out-of-State "800" number for Indianapolis is also corrected.

To assist in the tracking of appeal requests, please continue to include the following statement on all denial letters and Notices of Acceleration except Farmer Program acceleration.

"Please include a copy of this letter with your request for appeal."
