PURPOSE/INTENDED EFFECT:

This Administrative Notice (AN) adds the Program Authority Codes (PAC) for Multi-Family Housing to the list of contractors provided in FmHA AN No. 2703 (1910) dated December 4, 1992.

COMPARISON WITH PREVIOUS AN:

This AN augments FmHA AN No. 2703 (1910) dated December 4, 1992.

IMPLEMENTATION RESPONSIBILITIES:

Each program area has been assigned Program Authority Codes (PAC) to be used when ordering credit reports, which identify the costs as recoverable or nonrecoverable. The codes have not changed; however, they are listed below for your convenience in referring to the contractor list, which has been revised to include the order numbers and corresponding PAC for Multi-Family Housing.

Farmer Program Loan Processing = F1Y1 (Recoverable)
Farmer Program Loan Servicing = F2Y1 (Nonrecoverable)
Single Family Housing Loan Processing = S1Y1 (Recoverable)
Single Family Housing Loan Servicing = S2Y1 (Nonrecoverable)
Multi-Family Housing Loan Processing = M1Y1 (Recoverable)
Multi-Family Housing Loan Servicing = M2Y1 (Nonrecoverable)

Individual credit reports will be ordered in accordance with FmHA Instruction 1910-B from one of the five authorized contractors (or their affiliates) listed on the attached page. The appropriate program area order number and code must be entered on the order tickets under the signature block:
