SUBJECT: List Of Borrowers Provided To Business Firms

TO: State Directors, District Directors, and
County Offices

PURPOSE/INTENDED OUTCOME:

The purpose of this Administrative Notice (AN) is to notify State, District and County Offices that they should delay distributing a list of current borrowers to business firms.

COMPARISON WITH PREVIOUS AN:

No previous AN has been issued on the subject.

IMPLEMENTATION RESPONSIBILITIES:

Section 1962.13 of FmHA Instruction 1962-A authorizes Farmers Home Administration (FmHA) to provide potential purchasers of chattel and crop security with a list of FmHA's current borrowers. However, because of potential Privacy Act problems with this policy, all offices should delay the sending of such lists to business firms until a final rule is published in the Federal Register revising Exhibit C to FmHA Instruction 2015-E. You will be notified at that time to continue the notification procedure under Section 1962.13 of FmHA Instruction 1962-A.

ANY REVISIONS OR MODIFICATIONS TO THIS AN THAT YOU WISH TO PUBLISH AS A STATE DIRECTIVE MUST BE SUBMITTED AND APPROVED BY THE ASSISTANT ADMINISTRATOR, FARMER PROGRAMS BEFORE IT IS RELEASED FOR IMPLEMENTATION IN YOUR STATE. THE ONLY EXCEPTION TO THIS REQUIREMENT IS WHEN THE REVISION OR MODIFICATION IS NECESSARY FOR COMPLIANCE WITH STATE LAW.
