
SUBJECT: Processing of Economic Emergency (EE)  
Loan Applications

TO: All State Directors; Assistant Administrator, Accounting, and  
Director, Finance Office; Farmer Programs Chiefs; District  
Directors and County Supervisors

This AN supplements FmHA AN No. 1003 (1940) dated April 4, 1984.

It is anticipated that EE loan funds will be exhausted in most States within the near future. Therefore, after the State(s) insured and guaranteed EE loan allocations are exhausted, County Supervisors will not continue receiving and processing EE applications up to the point of approval as indicated in paragraph 5 of FmHA AN No. 1003 (1940).

At a later date, State Directors will be advised how to handle all unfunded EE applications still on hand.
