FY 1998 allocations of direct and guaranteed farm ownership and operating loans for individual States have been computed according to FmHA Instruction 1940-L. Individual State allocations are in Exhibit 1.

2 Loan Programs Not Funded or Not Allocated to States

A Programs Not Funded

The following Farm Loan Programs are not funded in FY 1998:

- Grazing Association
 - Guaranteed Farm Ownership with Interest Assistance
 - Irrigation and Drainage
 - Direct Soil and Water
 - Guaranteed Soil and Water.

B Programs Not Allocated to States

The following Farm Loan Programs are not allocated to States.

Emergency Loans - Loans may be obligated as loans are approved in designated area. The Appropriation Act for FY 1998 provides funding authority of \$25 million. A carryover supplemental appropriation of funds from FY 1997 totalling \$38.4 million is also available for use in FY 1998.

Credit Sales of Acquired Properties - Because of the limited allocation of \$25 million available in FY 1998, all funds will be held in the National Office.

Indian Tribal Land Acquisition Loans - Control of funds is being retained in the National Office. States should request funds from the Director, LMD. Funding authority for FY 1998 is \$1,002,000.

Direct Farm Ownership - Funding authority for FY 1998 is \$45.5 million. Because of the limitation of funds available in FY 1998, all funds will be retained in the National Office Reserve.

Each State is authorized to submit loan requests for each category (non-beginning farmer, beginning farmer, beginning farmer downpayment, SDA Ethnic, and SDA Gender).

All requests are to be submitted within 15 calendar days after receipt of this notice. States will be notified of the availability of funds for requests submitted.

The National Office will attempt to fund, at a minimum, 1 loan per category for each State from the limited allocation of funds available.

The Agriculture, Rural Development, Food and Drug Administration, and Related Agencies Appropriations Act, 1998 (Pub. L. 105-86), signed November 18, 1997, establishes funding levels for the following Farm Loan Programs:

- Direct Operating (see subparagraph B)
- Guaranteed Operating Unsubsidized (see subparagraph C)
- Guaranteed Operating Subsidized (see subparagraph D)
- Guaranteed Farm Ownership (see subparagraph E).

An administrative allocation has been made to Alaska, the Virgin Islands, Puerto Rico, and the Western Pacific Areas. The amount of the administrative allocation to these jurisdictions was \$800,000, \$400,000, \$6,000,000, and \$400,000, respectively.

An administrative allocation has been made to each State. Under the administrative allocation, each State received the same percentage of the FY 1998 allocation as the State received of the initial allocation in FY 1997.

An administrative allocation has been made to Alaska, the Virgin Islands, Puerto Rico, and the Western Pacific Areas. The amount of the administrative allocation to these jurisdictions was \$400,000, \$400,000, \$800,000, and \$400,000, respectively.

An administrative allocation has been made to each State. Under the administrative allocation, each State received 50 percent of their average obligations for FY 1996 and FY 1997.

A carryover supplemental appropriation of funds from FY 1997 totalling \$31 million is available for use in FY 1998. These funds are for use only by applications in counties with either primary or contiguous disaster declarations. These funds will be held in the National Reserve. Requests for these funds must contain a certification by SED that the applicant to be funded is located in a county which is eligible for disaster assistance. States may request funds after allotments are used.

An administrative allocation has been made to Alaska, the Virgin Islands, Puerto Rico, and the Western Pacific Areas. The amount of the administrative allocation to these jurisdictions was \$500,000, \$500,000, \$3,000,000, and \$500,000, respectively.

An administrative allocation has been made to each State. Under the administrative allocations, each State received 50 percent of their average obligations for FY 1996 and FY 1997.

When loan funds are suballocated on a county basis, Indian Reservations are to be treated as one county for allocation purposes.
