SUBJECT: Effective Date of FmHA Instruction
1940-G, Environmental Program

TO: All State Directors, District Directors
and County Supervisors

On January 30, 1984, Regulation 1940-G will be published in the Federal Register. The Regulation will be met by all applicants for financial assistance, subdivision approval and other actions which have not been approved prior to March 31, 1984. For loan and grant assistance, approval involves delivery of Form FmHA 1940-1 to the applicant.

However, all applicants (pre-applications and applications) for financial assistance and subdivision approval filed on or after January 30, 1984, must provide the information required by 1940-G.

If environmental program requirements under 1901-G have not been accomplished prior to March 31, 1984, even though approval has occurred, then Regulation 1940-G will be followed.

In those cases where the application for financial assistance, subdivision approval, or request for other action was filed on or before January 29, 1984, FmHA may be able to utilize information already submitted (supplemented as may be necessary) to meet environmental requirements for approval on or after March 31, 1984.
