**SUBJECT: Notification of Farmer Program Applicants
Regarding Loan Approval Action**

TO: State Directors and District Directors

ATTN: Farmer Program Chiefs

PURPOSE/INTENDED OUTCOME:

The purpose of this Administrative Notice is to clarify the meaning of the phrase "notified in writing" with respect to loan approval, as used in the text of FmHA Instruction 1910-A, Section 1910.4(i).

COMPARISON WITH PREVIOUS AN:

No previous AN has been issued on this subject.

IMPLEMENTATION RESPONSIBILITIES:

Section 1910.4(i) of FmHA Instruction 1910-A, Receiving and Processing Applications, states in part "and for Farmer Program loan applications, each application must be approved or disapproved and the applicant notified in writing, of the action taken, not later than 60 days after receipt of a completed application."

It has been determined that the receipt of a signed copy of Form FmHA 1940-1, REQUEST FOR OBLIGATION OF FUNDS, by the applicant is sufficient notice, and complies with 7 USC 1983a and 7 CFR
