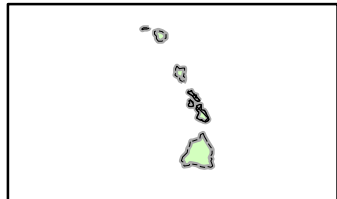
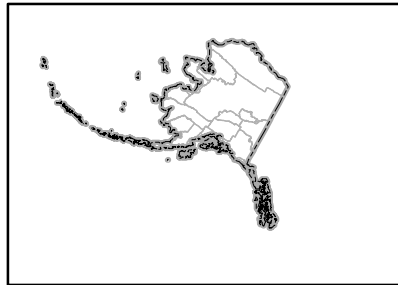
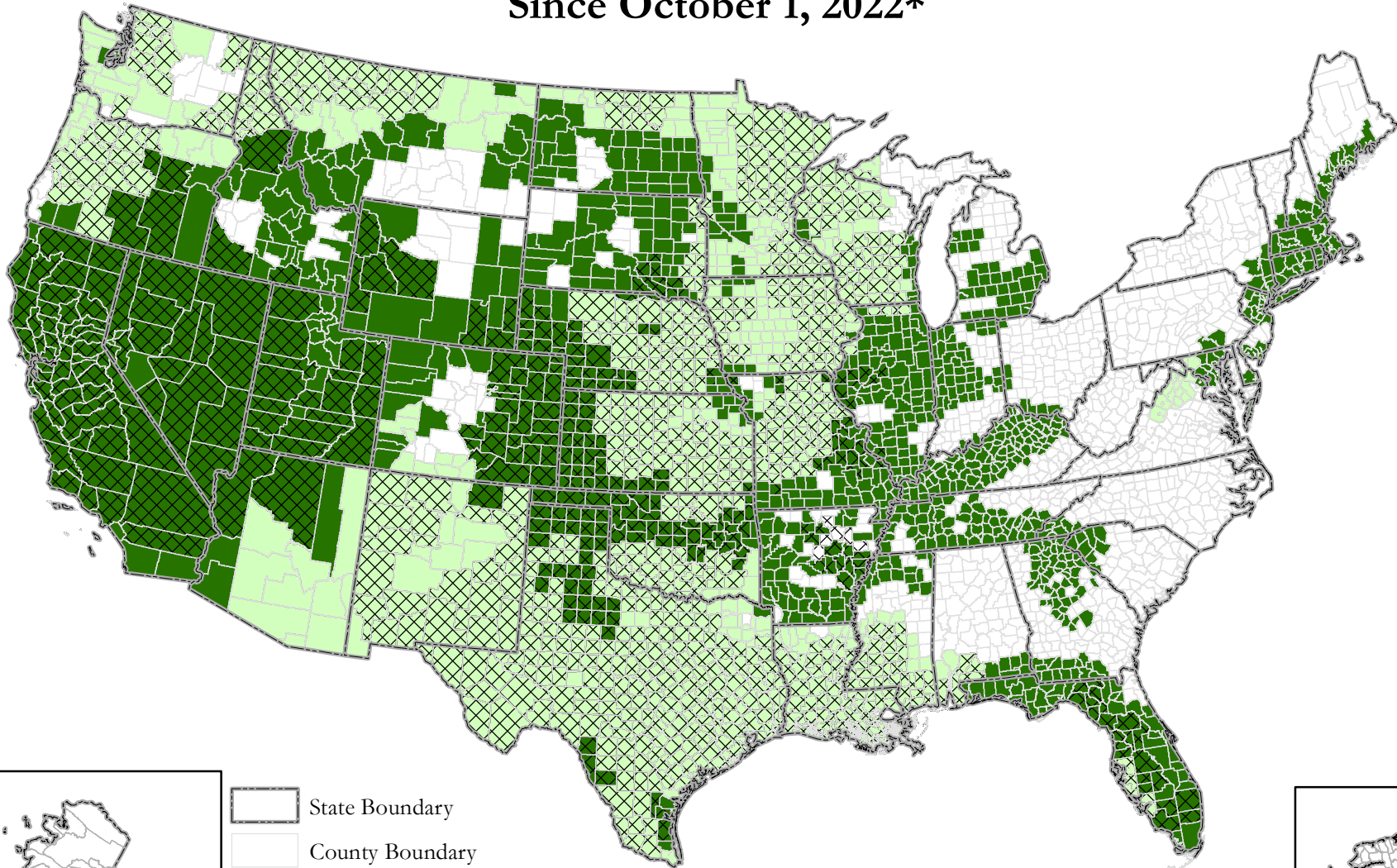





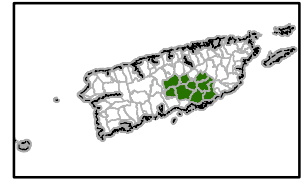


Counties Eligible for CRP Emergency Haying and Grazing Since October 1, 2022*

*Before haying and grazing, contact your FSA office to see if your county remains eligible and/or obtain a modified conservation plan. This list is for the current program year and current local conditions may have changed. After a county is approved for emergency haying and grazing, COC must review conditions on a monthly basis and determine whether continuing the emergency activities is warranted.

Counties eligible prior to October 1, of 2022 may be eligible for grazing or haying but any days utilized after the start of October 1, 2022 will count towards the total allowable days in 2023.
