Discount for Contaminated Oats

Oats found to contain substances poisonous to humans or animals, such as mercurial compounds and toxin-producing molds, will receive a discount equal to the settlement value determined after applying all other premiums and discounts.

Exception: For oats delivered to CCC and the warehouse receipt indicates a vomitoxin level of:

- 5 parts per million or less, determine the settlement rate in the normal manner
- more than 5 parts per million, the oats shall have a settlement value of **zero**.
