NAP coverage is NOT available on any crop where individual insurance is available in the County at any level of maturity. If insurance is not available we can cover the crop.

- Coverage begins the later of: 1 calendar days after the date CCC-471 is filed, or the date the crop is planted, not to exceed the final planting date
- Coverage ends the earlier of harvest, abandonment or destruction of the crop or the normal harvest date
