USDA Issues Additional Pandemic Assistance Payments for Underserved Producers

The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) Farm Service Agency (FSA) is currently making automatic Coronavirus Food Assistance Program 2 (CFAP 2) top-up payments to underserved farmers.

Payments will be based on the 2020 program certification on form <u>CCC-860</u>, <u>Socially Disadvantaged</u>, <u>Limited Resource</u>, <u>Beginning and Veteran Farmer or Rancher</u> Certification.

Producers who have not previously certified to their status for the 2020 program year have until February 10, 2023, to submit form CCC-860 to be eligible for the additional payments.
